The Rules and Conditions under which the scholarships are awarded and the program administered shall be:

- (1) The number and amount of the scholarship awards will be determined by the income available to the Shippensburg Fish and Game Association as established by the Board of Directors.
- (2). The scholarship funds may only be used to defray necessary costs of the student's education (i.e. tuition, room & board, books & supplies, fees and equipment required by the student's particular course of study or school).
- (3). The scholarship recipient may reapply for the scholarship annually

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(4). Scholarship checks will be issued upon presentation by the applicant of a letter of acceptance from the educational institution and an acknowledgment of intent to attend that institution. It is the normal and customary procedure that the scholarship check will be a two-party check made payable to the student and school.

(5) Applications shall remain the sole property of the Shippensburg Fish and Game Association and may be destroyed at their discretion.
