Called to order by board chairman Jerrid Lozenski.

Prices for a new tractor were discussed. Prices compared were for a Kabota or John Deere. Kabota would require the purchase of new forks. It was suggested we trade in the one we have. Might get between \$9,000. and \$10,000 trade in or more with a private sale. It would need some repairs first that might cost around \$1,000. to \$2,000. John Deere has one available now and Kabota might have one the beginning of next year. The John Deere can be finance with zero interest for 5 years and will be delivered free.

M-S-P to purchase the John Deere and finance it for 5 years.

There used to be a finance committee to plan for future projects and decided what order they needed to be done. Set of the goals for the future.

Some things that need to planned for are-
replace the roof on the short range,
bury the water line and install a frost free hydrant at cooking area,
put a metal roof over the cooking area
put down a macadam slab in the cooking area add more cookers.

We have a price quote from Snoke's Excavating to lower the water line.
M-S-P to have Snoke's Excavating lower the water line and do it this year.

Jerrid needs to measure and get a price for supplies to replace the roof on short range.

Who will plow snow this winter?

John Coover did it in the past but he has sold his business and may not be able to do it this year.

Trail of Life, a church based group for youths wants to use the ranges to train its members in the use of rifles, black powder guns shot guns.. They will have their instructors and Andy can be used as the NRA instructor for the group.

He will still be the liaison for construction work for project for the club.
