Trap-winter league update- ahead by 8 birds with three shoots left for the year. They will probably be hosting a money shoot on April 6th.

Trap house repair-lower house has crumbling block and water is getting into the trap house.

Randy got an estimate for repair from Greg Raudabaugh. Estimate for time and materials for both Trap Houses is \$2960.00 worst case scenario. Contractor thinks it could be less. Estimate includes power washing, replacing outside 4 inches of deteriorated block and coating all sides and tops with Conproco coating. Will check with Jerrid to see if this is in the ballpark for repairs. Later in the meeting a motion was made to do the repairs. M-S-P
